



PARENT / GUARDIAN RULES & GUIDELINES

WHEN	WHO	CONTROLS REQUIRED
Until FA, Government & PHE guidance changes	The Club	<p>Your club will designate a Covid-19 officer who will be responsible for developing & overseeing The Covid-19 officer will continually monitor how compliance is being observed within the club. The Covid-19 officer for your club will be responsible for communicating the code of behaviour to all players, coaches and volunteers within the club. The Club must support NHS test and trace efforts by collecting name and contact information of participants at both training and matches. This information will be stored for a minimum of 21 days in-line with the Government Recreational Team Sport Framework and collected/processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018 and in line with GDPR principles. It will only be used for the purpose of NHS test and trace.</p>
	Training Sessions & Matches	<p>Competitive training sessions will take place for all participants, unless the club is given prior notice, then alternative sessions will be arranged. Sessions to be delivered only in outdoor settings. Sessions will take place in groups of no more than 30 (including coaches). Coaches will ensure that a designated drink storage area (a minimum of 1m apart) is available for each participant in the session. Each coach will ensure that themselves and each participant in their session has used the hand sanitizing station provided before the start of each session. Each coach will ensure that current government guidelines regarding social distancing measures are adhered to before & after each session finishes. If a coach notices that a participant becomes Covid-19 symptomatic during the activity, they will immediately be removed from the session. The players parent / guardian & the clubs Covid-19 officer will be made aware of the situation.</p>
	Spectators / Parents / Guardians	<p>Supporters, parents, and other spectators will remain socially distanced whilst attending training / matches. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six-person gathering limits and spread out ensuring space is available for club & facility officials & coaches.</p>
